



Antietam Pool Rules and Regulations

- Members must show their membership card in order to enter the pool area. Non-swimmers 4 years of age or older must have their medallion attached to the left leg of their swim suit. Guests of members must be paid for at the gate before entering the pool area.
- A family membership is any membership that includes a parent and a child under age 23. Up to 2 children and 2 adults who reside in the same household may be included in a family membership, any additional children are \$20 each. Children who have not yet turned 4 as of May 1 are free.
- Two-person membership is for 2 adults age 18 or older who reside in the same household.
 - Single membership is for 1 adult age 18 or older.
 - Senior memberships are available to those who are age 60+ by May 1.
- Any false information on the Pool Membership Application is cause to forfeit the membership with no refund.
 - Any member caught giving medallions or ID cards to non-members will forfeit their membership without a refund.
- The use of balls, rafts and flotation devices in the pool may be limited or curtailed by members of the Antietam Pool Staff.
 - No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool area.
 - Pets are not allowed in the pool area.
 - No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
- Antietam Pool is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen personal property.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers while in the pool.
 - Smoking is not permitted in the pool area, or in the entrance area.
